MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS 23 - 24 SEPTEMBER 2022

Every four years, residents across the Czech Republic vote for new representatives at their local town halls. Are you a citizen of the EU and live in Brno? Please come and elect the future government of your city in the municipal elections. Even a single vote can change the future.

THE RIGHT TO VOTE APPLIES TO CITIZENS:

- of EU member states.
- older than 18 years,
- with a permanent or temporary residence permit.

I AM GOING TO VOTE IN THE MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS IN THE CZECH REPUBLIC FOR THE FIRST TIME

To be able to vote, you need to apply for entry in the annex to the voter list at the town hall according to your residency. You need to do so by 21 September 2022 (by 16:00).



1) Fill in the form. The link to download the form can be found on **en.brno.cz/elections2022**.



2) Deliver it to your city district office either in person, or by mail (if you have a data box, you can send it electronically). The link to the list of city districts and their addresses can be found on **en.brno.cz/elections2022**.



3) The same city district office will inform you of where the polling station is and will issue the ballot papers to you. These can also be picked up in the polling station during the elections.

I HAVE ALREADY VOTED IN THE MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS IN THE CZECH REPUBLIC

If you have not changed your address since the last municipal elections, you are already entered in the annex to the voter list and can go and vote directly. If you have changed your address, you need to register again (see above).

ELECTION DAYS: 23 - 24 SEPTEMBER 2022

- Please come to the polling station in the city district according to your residency - the list of polling stations can be found on <u>volby.tmapy.cz</u>.
- Please bring a valid ID document with you.
- You can cast your vote with the ballot papers you received at the registration. They are available also at the polling station.
